Those movies all show different taste of Japan.

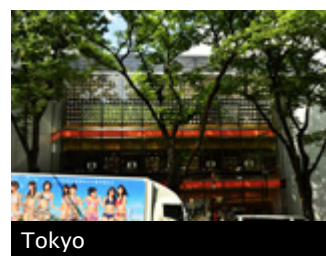
