Have you seen Miyazaki Hayao's masterpiece Princess Mononoke? The thousand year old trees that created the mystical forests of this famous movie can be found on the island of Yakushima. Though small, Yakushima is microcosm for the natural bounty of the Japanese archipelago, which encompasses a wide variety of ecological habitats due to its long stretch from north to south. These features have contributed to it being designated as a Natural World Heritage by UNESCO. The cedars of this island, one which dates back over 7200 years, never fail to leave a deep impression on visitors.

Yakushima is also a resort that boasts mountains, ocean, lush forests, and rivers, and a veteran nature guide from the Yakushima Guide Association will make sure you enjoy your visit to the fullest.
