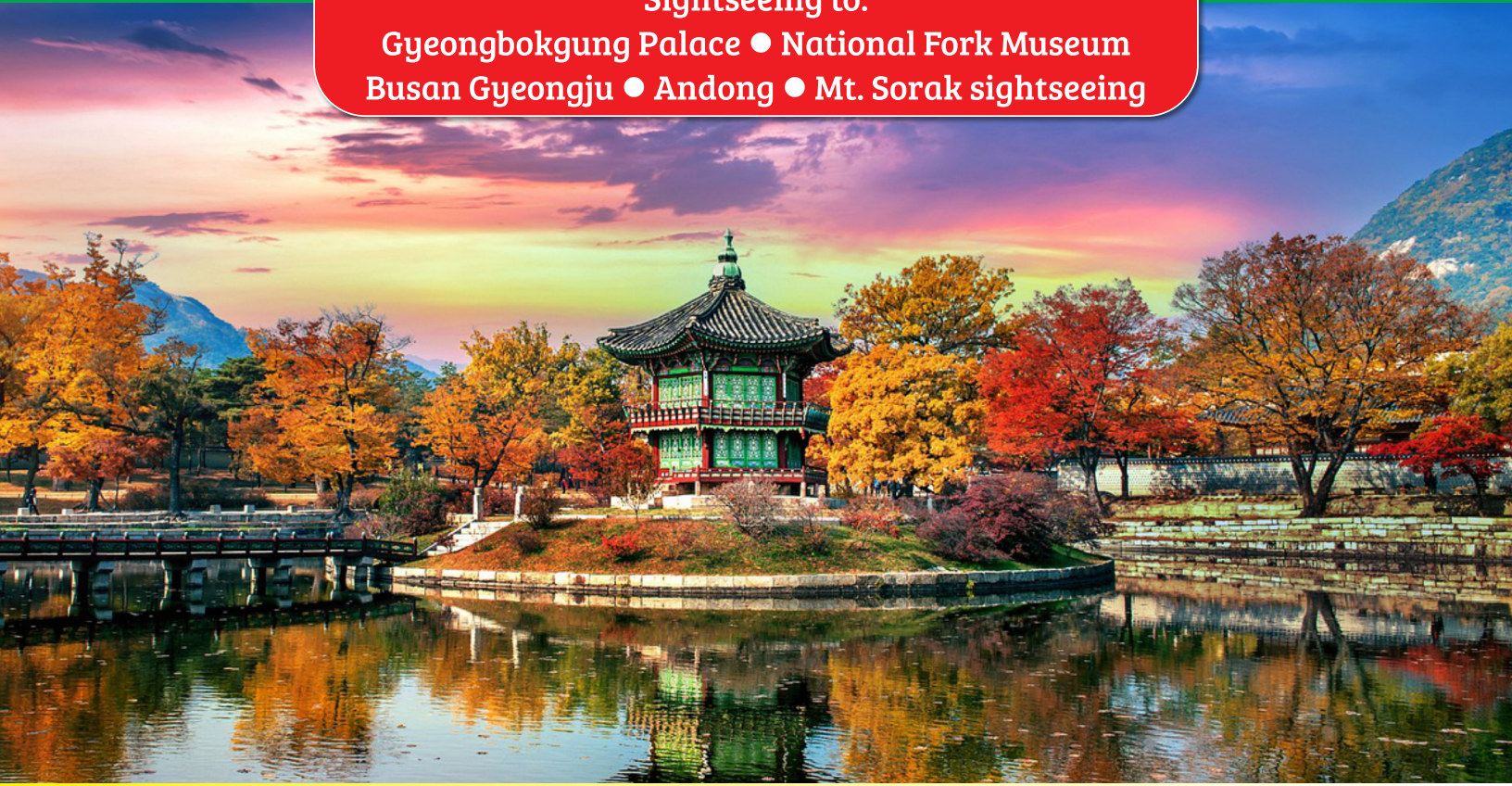

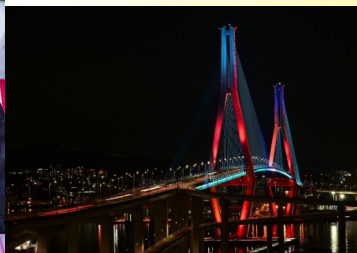

| Day 4<br><b>WED</b> | Gyeongju<br>Andong<br>Pyeongchang | <p>Breakfast at your hotel → <a href="#">Seokguram Grotto(UNESCO)</a>, constructed by Kim Dae-Seong during the reign of King Gyeong-Deok (742-765) of the Silla Kingdom. → <a href="#">Bulguksa Buddhist Temple(UNESCO)</a> The beauty of the temple itself and artistic touch of the stone relics are as awesome and fascinating as to be highly praised by visitors from all over the world → Move to Andong (170km/ 2hr 30min) → <a href="#">Andong Hahoe Village(UNESCO)</a> which has preserved the housing architecture and the village structure of the Joseon Dynasty. Moreover, the Village was naturally formed with people who actually live there. It has become world-famous for the visit of Queen Elizabeth II of The Great Britain. →</p> <p>Move to Pyeongchang (234km/ 2hr 30min), 2018 Winter Olympic host city → Check in a hotel.</p>  <p><b>HOTEL : RAMADA Hotel PyeongChang +82-33-333-1000 <a href="http://www.pyeongchangramadahotel.com">www.pyeongchangramadahotel.com</a> or similar (4STAR)</b></p> | Hotel-<br>breakfast |

| Day 5<br>THU | Pyeong-chang<br>Mt.Sorak<br>Seoul | <p>Breakfast at your hotel → Drive around Venues of 2018 Winter Olympic Games → Move to Sokcho(100km/ 1hr 30min). Stop by Gangneung Hangho beach, BTS Bus station : Album Jackets : You never walk alone (If time is available). Visit Seoraksan National Park(UNESCO Biosphere Zone), Seoraksan National Park, the peaks of the Seoraksan Mountains break through the clouds while jade-like water flows through the valleys, creating breathtaking views and making this Korea's most famous national park. Due to the many rare species found here, UNESCO designated this national park a Biosphere Preservation District in 1982. *Cable car to Gwongeumseong Fortress (Optional for cable car USD20pp)→ Move to Seoul (195km/ 3hr 30min). The location for arrival: The Donghwa Duty Free Shop Building.
