11:50 AM

# Day 2 Oct 16 (Thu) Arrival Day: Seoul (D)

5:10 PM

Arrive at Incheon International Airport. After immigration, claim your luggage and wait for your tour escort before exchanging currency and exiting customs. Meet our guide and transfer to dinner at a local restaurant in Seoul's main seaport.

After dinner our Incheon hotel is just three minutes from the airport, perfect after a long flight!

# Day 3 Oct 17 (Fri) Korea, the Land of Morning Calm (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Today's trip through **Gapyeong County** takes us to K-Drama locations used in Endless Love: Winter Sonata, My Love from the Star, I am Not a Robot and more. The name of the **Garden of Morning Calm**, which houses more than 5,000 varieties of plants, originated with the Indian poet Rabindranāth Tagore, who called Korea the "Land of Morning Calm".

Lunch at local restaurant, then on to **Nami Island**, certified as a **UNICEF Child Friendly Park**. Nami Island is also known as the **Naminara Republic** for its unique and original cultural and artistic atmosphere and is a prime Hallyu (Korean Wave) location. Head out to **Mt. Seorak** and Korea's most popular national park, and a favorite site for the colors of autumn.

#### Accommodations at the Sokcho Ramada or similar

#### Day 4 Oct 18 (Sat) Mt. Seorak, the Backbone of Korea (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Depart for sightseeing with guide by a chartered bus - enter **Seorak National Park**, a **UNESCO Biosphere Protection** site, and ascend over **Sinheungsa Temple** and the **Great Unification Budda** to the traces of **Gwongeumseong Fortress** by cable car for one of the best views of the famous Ulsanbawi rock formations. Visit the local fishing town of **Daepohang Port**, famous as the site for the hit K-drama "Strong Girl Bong Soon", before heading back to our hotel.

## Day 5 Oct 19 (Sun) Hahoe Folk Village – Mt. Juwang – Daegu (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. This morning, we will head to **Andong**, the center of the Confucian culture in Korea, for a visit to the **UNESCO World Heritage Hahoe Folk Village**, where descendants of the Ryu clan of Pungsan still live here in Joseon Dynasty traditional houses today. The village became even more famous after Queen Elizabeth of England visited on April 21, 1999. After lunch proceed to **Mt. Juwang**, regarded as one of the top three rocky mountains in Korea and a local favorite for viewing the autumn colors along the **Jubang Valley Trail**.

Tonight, we will stay in Daegu, the third largest city in Korea after Pusan and Seoul.

Accommodations at the Daegu Grand Hotel or similar

#### Day 6 Oct 20 (Mon) Gyeongju, Ancient Capitol of Silla – the Museum Without Walls (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Depart for sightseeing with guide by a chartered bus for **Gyeongju**, the ancient capital of Korea and a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, sometimes called the "Museum Without Walls". Explore the Silla period at the **Gyeongju National Museum**, featuring Asia's largest bell, the bronze Divine Bell of King Seongdeok – also called the "Emile" ("mommy") bell, and visit the ancient tombs in **Tumuli Park**. Later, we will visit the **Bulguksa Temple**, which was designated as a **World Cultural Asset by UNESCO** and is classified as **Historic and Scenic Site No. 1** by the South Korean government. Gyeongju is also home to **Bomun Lake**, one of CNN's "50 Beautiful places to visit in Korea".

### Accommodations at the Daegu Grand Hotel or similar

## Day 7 Oct 21 (Tue) Daegu to Busan, UNESCO Creative City of Film (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch at local restaurant, dinner on your own. Depart for Busan and sightseeing with guide by a chartered bus. On the way we'll stop by **Guam Farm Stay Village** for apple picking (Daegu's nickname is "Apple City"). In Busan, visit **Jagalchi Market**, Korea's largest seafood market, where most of the fish sellers are "ajumma" – middle aged Korean women. Enjoy shopping in this huge shopping area that includes **BIFF Square** (named for the **Busan International Film Festival**), the traditional **Gukje Market** (featured in the film "Ode to My Father"), the **Gwangbok-dong** fashion street and the **Nampo-dong** food streets.

#### Accommodations at the Asti Hotel Busan or similar

# Day 8 Oct 22 (Wed) Jeonju, the Birthplace of Bibimbap (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, and then depart with guide by a chartered bus for **Jeonju** - the birthplace of bibimbap, a designated **UNESCO City of Gastronomy**, and a part of **Cittaslow** (the international network of Slow Cities). Visit the **Jeonju Hanok Village** for **Hanbok wearing** and a **bibimbap making experience** — make your own traditional lunch, and then take in the scenic view from the **Omokdae Pavillion** (where Lee Seonggae, known as King Taejo, the founder of the Joseon Dynasty, stopped to hold a banquet to celebrate his victory against the Japanese invasion at Hwangsan Mount). Dinner at local restaurant.

#### Accommodations at the Lahan Hotel Jeonju or similar

# Day 9 Oct 23 (Thu) Jeonju to Yongin via Taean (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch at local restaurant. Depart with guide by a chartered bus to the **Taean Autumn Flower Festival**, at the **Korea Flower Park**. Spend the afternoon and evening at **Everland**, Korea's largest amusement park, covering some 1,200,000 square yards, divided into five zones which include a zoo, gardens, food and shopping, and of course – rides, including the world's steepest wooden rollercoaster, the 3<sup>rd</sup> longest wooden rollercoaster in the world! Dinner on your own at Everland. Return to hotel after closing fireworks around 9PM. Our hotel is 5 minutes from **Jeondae Everland Station**, with free shuttles to and from Everland.

#### Accommodations at Hotel Golden Tulip Ever Yongin or similar

## Day 10 Oct 24 (Fri) Seoul (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. We'll start the morning at the Gangnam Tourist Information Center, and then talk a walk down **K-Star Road**, "where stars are made" – an area of Gangnam where you will be immersed in the Korean Wave/K-pop culture (and maybe catch a glimpse of your favorite K-pop idols if we're lucky).

In the afternoon we'll head to **Alive Museum**, Seoul's premier interactive 4-D optical illusion museum, and then spend some time shopping at **Insadong shopping street**, filled with traditional Korean crafts, souvenir shops and unique street food.

Later on, enjoy a performance of **Nanta** – this non-verbal comedy is the longest running show in Korean history!

In the evening we'll view the glorious skyline of Seoul from the **Han River** on our evening **dinner cruise! Accommodations at Hotel Kukdo Seoul or similar** 

# Day 11 Oct 25 (Sat) Seoul – Palaces and Shopping (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, Lunch and dinner at local restaurant. Depart with guide by a chartered bus. In the morning visit **Gyeongbokgung Palace**, the main palace of the five-hundred-year Joseon Dynasty, with a stop at the **National Folk Museum** located on the grounds of the palace. Lunch on your own and shopping at **Gwanjang Market**, one of Seoul's largest traditional markets, then back to **Myeongdong** for more shopping and a stop at the 8 story **Myeongdong Daiso** mega-store. Return to hotel.

## Day 12 Oct 26 (Sun) Departure Day: Seoul – Honolulu (B, L)

Buffet breakfast at hotel, lunch at local restaurant and dinner on your own. Stop at **Lotte Mart** on the way to the airport for lunch and last-minute shopping.

8:20 PM Depart for Honolulu on **Asiana Airlines flight OZ 232**, meal and snack served on the flight.
