## Day 1 Jul 2 (Wed) Honolulu – Incheon

11:50 AM Depart for Incheon on **Asiana Airlines flight OZ 231**, meal and snack served on the flight. Asiana Airlines was recognized as the first environmentally friendly company within the service industry by the South Korean Ministry of the Environment. #### Day 2 Jul 3 (Thu) Arrival Day: Incheon (D)

5:10 PM Arrive at Incheon International Airport. After immigration, claim your luggage and wait for your tour escort before exchanging currency and exiting customs.

Meet our local English-speaking guide and transfer to our Incheon hotel and dinner at a local restaurant in Seoul's main seaport.

After dinner our Incheon hotel is just three minutes from the airport, perfect after a long flight! Accommodations at Best Western Premier Incheon Airport Hotel or similar

#### Day 3 Jul 4 (Fri) Incheon to Yongin and Everland! (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch at local restaurant and dinner on your own at Everland

In the morning depart for **Wawoojeongsa Temple**, home to more than 3,000 images of the Buddha and the Guiness Book World's Record largest wooden Buddha head in the world.

Spend the afternoon and evening at **Everland**, Korea's largest amusement park, covering some 1,200,000 square yards, divided into five zones which include a zoo, gardens, food and shopping, and of course – rides, including the world's steepest wooden rollercoaster, the 3<sup>rd</sup> longest wooden rollercoaster in the world! Dinner on your own at Everland.

Return to hotel after closing fireworks around 9PM. Our hotel is 5 minutes from **Jeondae Everland Station**, with free shuttles to and from Everland.

### Day 5 Jul 5 (Sat) Yongin to Buyeo, the ancient Capitol of Korea! (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants.

Today we will get a glimpse at life in the ancient Baekje Kingdom with a visit to **Baekje Cultural Land**, the largest historical cultural park in Korea, and learn more of the history at the **Buyeo National Museum**.

Buyeo's other name is **"Lotus Town"** – we'll get a chance to check out the height of the Lotus season and the **Buyeo Seodong Lotus Festival** (festival schedule pending).

Afterwards, enjoy shopping at **Lotte Outlet Buyeo Branch**, 17,000 square meters of outlet shopping, local specialty stores and restaurants before checking in at our hotel, attached to the **Lotte Outlet** shopping mall.

Accommodations at Lotte Resort Buyeo or similar

#### Day 6 Jul 6 (Sun) Buyeo to Jeonju (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, and then depart with guide by a chartered bus for **Jeonju** - the birthplace of bibimbap, a designated **UNESCO City of Gastronomy**, and a part of **Cittaslow** (the international network of Slow Cities).

Visit the Jeonju Hanok Village for Hanbok (traditional Korean clothing) wearing and a bibimbap making experience – make your own traditional lunch! Then visit the Jeonju Traditional Hanji Center for a glimpse of Korean traditional paper making. Dinner at local restaurant. Accommodations at the Lahan Hotel Jeonju or similar

#### Day 7 Jul 7 (Mon) Seoul, My Seoul (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, and then depart with guide by a chartered bus for our return to Seoul.

In the afternoon we'll head to **Alive Museum**, Seoul's premier interactive 4-D optical illusion museum, and then spend some time shopping at **Insadong shopping street**, filled with traditional Korean crafts, souvenir shops and unique street food.

In the evening enjoy a **Han River Dinner Cruise**. The Han River divides Seoul into North and South – Gangbuk (North of the River) and Gangnam (South of the River).

#### Day 8 Jul 8 (Tue) Experience Seoul! (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. In the morning we're off to **Namsangol Hanok Village**, for a traditional **Korean culture experience**.

We'll make our own lunch today during our **Kimbap making experience** – Kimbap are Korean seaweed and rice rolls that are sometimes called sushi but can contain many kinds of foods.

After lunch we'll head out to **Myeongdong** for shopping, including the largest Daiso in Korea (8 stories!). Myeongdong is also a great place to try out some of Korea's many popular street foods!

Later on, enjoy a performance of **Nanta** – this non-verbal comedy is the longest running show in Korean history!

#### Day 9 Jul 9 (Wed) Departure Day: Seoul – Honolulu (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Leave luggage at front desk and check by 12 pm. Enjoy free time for shopping and exploring until we depart for the airport. Stop by a local **Lotte Mart** on the way to the airport for last minute shopping and Korea kine Omiyage!
