Day 1 Jun 8 (Sun) Honolulu – Incheon

11:50 AM Depart for Incheon on **Asiana Airlines flight OZ 231**, meal and snack served on the flight. Asiana Airlines was recognized as the first environmentally friendly company within the service industry by the South Korean Ministry of the Environment. Day 2 Jun 9 (Mon) Arrival Day: Incheon (D)

5:10 PM Arrive at Incheon International Airport. After immigration, claim your luggage and wait for your tour escort before exchanging currency and exiting customs.

Meet our local English-speaking guide and transfer to our Incheon hotel and a **Jjajangmyeon** (noodles in black bean sauce) dinner at a local restaurant in Seoul's main seaport, a delicacy that was born in the Incheon area and is often featured in K-Dramas.

After dinner our Incheon hotel is just three minutes from the airport, perfect after a long flight! Accommodations at Best Western Premier Incheon Airport Hotel or similar

Day 3 Jun 10 (Tue) Suwon to Yongin (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Depart by chartered bus with local Englishspeaking guide for the **UNESCO World Heritage Hwaseong Fortress**, one of Korea's most important historical treasures and is the only remaining walled fortress in the country.

Lunch at local restaurant – let's try **Galbi**, the beef short ribs that are one of the specialties of Suwon.

After lunch we'll visit the **Korean Folk Village**, Korea's first open air museum, featuring real historical houses and buildings from around the country. It has also been the film location for many famous K-Dramas, including My Love from the Star, Dream High, The King and I, Dae Jang Geum, Tears of the Dragon, 500 Years of Joseon, Tale of the Nine-Tailed, and more!

Transfer to our hotel near Everland – local pork barbecue dinner at a nearby restaurant. Accommodations at Hotel Golden Tulip Ever Yongin or similar

Day 5 Jun 11 (Wed) Wawoojeongsa Temple and Everland! (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch at local restaurant and dinner on your own at Everland

In the morning depart for **Wawoojeongsa Temple**, home to more than 3,000 images of the Buddha and the Guiness Book World's Record largest wooden Buddha head in the world.

Lunch at local restaurant – let's try the local specialty **Naengkongguk**, cold noodles in soy bean soup, perfect for a hot summer's day!

Spend the afternoon and evening at **Everland**, Korea's largest amusement park, covering some 1,200,000 square yards, divided into five zones which include a zoo, gardens, food and shopping, and of

course – rides, including the world's steepest wooden rollercoaster, the 3rd longest wooden rollercoaster in the world! Dinner on your own at Everland.

Return to hotel after closing fireworks around 9PM. Our hotel is 5 minutes from **Jeondae Everland Station**, with free shuttles to and from Everland.

Accommodations at Hotel Golden Tulip Ever Yongin or similar

Day 6 Jun 12 (Thu) Nami Island – Petit France – Seoul (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Depart for **Nami Island**, which also calls itself the "Naminara Republic". Birthplace of the Hallyu – the Korean Wave of popular culture when it was used as a film location for "Winter Sonata", it features spectacular natural views and unique and original sculptures and activities.

For lunch we'll try a local Nami favorite, **Dakgalbi** – spicy grilled chicken and vegetables.

Before we head back to Seoul we will make a stop at **Petite France**, a slice of Europe in Korea that was inspired by Antoine de Saint-Exupéry's novel Le Petit Prince (The Little Prince). Many famous K-Dramas, such as "Beethoven Virus", "Personal Taste", "My Love From The Star", "Secret Garden", "Great Friend Note – Girls Generation Episode" and "Running Man", were filmed on the grounds.

Return to Seoul, dinner at local restaurant - **black chicken Samgyetang** at **Tosokchon Samgyetang or similar**, a classic summer dish made with a special chicken that actually has black flesh, skin, and bones!

Our Seoul hotel is located in the middle of the **Myeongdong** and **Dongdaemun** shopping districts, and close to **Insadong** shopping street.

Accommodations at Hotel Kukdo Seoul or similar

Day 7 Jun 13 (Fri) Seoul, My Seoul (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. We'll start the morning at the Gangnam Tourist Information Center, and then talk a walk down **K-Star Road**, "where stars are made" – an area of Gangnam where you will be immersed in the Korean Wave/K-pop culture (and maybe catch a glimpse of your favorite K-pop idols if we're lucky).

For lunch we'll try **Tteokbokki** - these chewy rice cakes are one of the most popular comfort and street foods in Korea!

After lunch we'll head out to **Myeongdong** for shopping, including the largest Daiso in Korea (8 stories!). Myeongdong is also a great place to try out some of Korea's many popular street foods!

Later on, enjoy a performance of **Nanta** – this non-verbal comedy is the longest running show in Korean history!

At the end of a hot day let's try **Pyongyang Naengmyeon**, the popular summer cold noodle dish that originated in North Korea, for dinner.

Accommodations at Hotel Kukdo Seoul or similar

Day 8 Jun 14 (Sat) Experience Seoul! (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants. In the morning we're off to **Namsangol Hanok Village**, for some traditional Korean cultural experiences (specific experiences subject to operation and availability).

We'll make our own lunch today during our **Kimbap making experience** – Kimbap are Korean seaweed and rice rolls that are sometimes called sushi but can contain many kinds of foods. We'll also get a chance to experience trying on Hanbok here – traditional Korean clothing.

In the afternoon we'll head to **Alive Museum**, Seoul's premier interactive 4-D optical illusion museum, and then spend some time shopping at **Insadong shopping street**, filled with traditional Korean crafts, souvenir shops and unique street food.

In the evening enjoy a **Han River Dinner Cruise**. The Han River divides Seoul into North and South – Gangbuk (North of the River) and Gangnam (South of the River). Saturday is **fireworks day** on the Hangang (Han River)!

Day 9 Jun 15 (Sun) Departure Day: Seoul – Honolulu (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Leave luggage at front desk and check by 12 pm. Enjoy free time for shopping and exploring until we depart for the airport. Stop by a local **Lotte Mart** on the way to the airport for last minute shopping and Korea kine Omiyage!

8:20 PM Depart for Honolulu on **Asiana Airlines flight OZ 232**, meal and snack served on the flight. **Arrive at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport on the same day at 10:10 AM** *Welcome Home!*
