Day 1 Feb 10 (Mon) Honolulu – Seoul

11:10 AM

Depart for Incheon on **Asiana Airlines flight OZ 231**, meal and snack served on the flight (11h 20m flight, Boeing 777, 3-3-3 seating). Day 2 Feb 11 (Tue) Arrival Day: Seoul to Hanoi

5:30 PM Arrive at Incheon International Airport, awarded the World's Best Airport Staff Service by Skytrax in

2023. wait for your tour escort and then transfer for your flight to Hanoi.

7:30 PM Depart for Vietnam on Asiana Airlines flight OZ 733, meal served on the flight (4h 30m flight, Airbus

A333, 2-4-2 seating).

10:00 PM Arrive in Hanoi at **Nội Bài International Airport**, Vietnam's busiest airport. **Wait for your tour escort and**

proceed as a group to immigration, where we have arranged for special **Fast Track** processing. After immigration, claim your luggage and **wait for your tour escort** before exchanging currency and exiting

customs.

Meet our local English-speaking guide and transfer to our Hanoi hotel. Our hotel tonight is located in the center of the Hanoi Old Quarter, convenient to all that the capitol city has to offer and is rated 100 out of 100 for walkers on Trip Advisor.

Accommodations at Silk Path Hotel Hanoi or similar

Day 3 Feb 12 (Wed) Inside the River - Hanoi City Tour (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants.

This morning, we will depart by chartered coach with English speaking guide to explore **Hanoi**, whose name means "Inside the River", due to its location between the Red and Black Rivers.

We will visit the fascinating **Old Quarter** - 36 ancient streets where peddlers continue to trade as they have done for centuries, the **Hoàn Kiếm Lake** area (Hanoi's heart, and one of the four original districts of Hanoi), the **Hanoi Opera House (Nhà hát lớn Hà Nội)**, and the St. Joseph's, the **Grand Cathedral of Hanoi (Nhà thờ Lớn Hà Nội)**, named after the patron saint of Vietnam.

We continue our tour with a visit to the **President Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (Lăng Chủ tịch Hồ Chí Minh)**, the last resting place of the Vietnamese revolutionary and president - set on the spot in Ba Dinh square where Ho Chi Minh first declared independence from French rule in 1945.

Then we will visit the **Humble House on Stilts** from which "Uncle Ho", as he is affectionately known, ruled Vietnam until his death in 1969. Our final stop of the day will be at Hanoi's first University, the **Temple of Literature (Quoc Tu Giam)**, built in 1070.

Accommodations at Silk Path Hotel Hanoi or similar

Day 4 Feb 13 (Thu) Hanoi to UNESCO World Heritage Ha Long Bay (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch on cruise, and dinner at local restaurant.

Depart for a day trip to UNESCO World Heritage Ha Long ("Descending Dragon") Bay.

There we will take a magical 4 hour cruise around the bay. Considered Vietnam's greatest natural wonder, **Ha Long Bay** is home to over 3,000 islands, said to have been formed by a family of dragons sent by the gods to protest Vietnam, that jut out of the sea to provide a spectacular natural environment.

Stop for a refreshing swim in a secluded bay at **Titop Island** (weather permitting), named after Russian cosmonaut Gherman Titov, the second man to orbit the earth. We will also take the opportunity to enjoy a fresh seafood lunch on board our boat.

Return to our Hanoi hotel in the afternoon, dinner at local restaurant.

Day 5 Feb 14 (Fri) Hanoi to Huế (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants.

Today we will fly to **Huế**, the ancient capital of the Nguyen Dynasty, nestled along the banks of the Perfume River.

4:35 PM Depart for Huế on Vietnam Airlines flight VN1545.

5:50 PM Arrive in Huế at **Phu Bai International Airport**. Claim your luggage and **wait for your tour escort** before exiting.

Our hot spring hotel is located in the heart of Huế, just a few minutes from the Perfume River. The mineral water in the hot spring is sourced from the geothermal hot springs which Dr. Albert Sallet discovered in 1928

Accommodations at the Alba Spa Hotel or similar

Day 6 Feb 15 (Sat) UNESCO World Heritage Huế (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants.

After breakfast we'll embark on a delightful boat trip along the romantic **Perfume River** to visit the **Thiên Mụ Pagoda**, which is the oldest and most revered site in Hue, its iconic seven-story Phước Duyên pagoda is regarded as the unofficial symbol of the city.

Next, we will visit the **Tomb of Khải Định** and the **Tomb of Tự Đức**. The kings of the Nguyen Dynasty designed their own tombs, reflecting their varying temperaments, philosophies, and priorities, and are a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Take a break for lunch at a local restaurant, for delicious traditional Vietnamese cuisine.

In the afternoon, we will continue our tour with an exploration of **the Imperial Citadel**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that showcases the grandeur and sophistication of the Nguyen Dynasty. Discover the fascinating history and architecture of the **Purple Forbidden City**, which was once the exclusive domain of the emperors and their royal family.

Next, visit the **Thuy Xuan Incense Village**, where you can witness the traditional process of making incense and learn about its cultural significance in Vietnam.

Finally, head to **Đông Ba Market**, the largest and most vibrant market in Hue, and shop till we drop for souvenirs, handicrafts, and local specialties.

Accommodations at the Alba Spa Hotel or similar

Day 7 Feb 16 (Sun) UNESCO World Heritage Hội An (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants.

After having breakfast at our hotel, we will depart for **Hội An**.

On the way we'll make a stop at the beautiful **Hai Van Pass** to take in the stunning views of Son Tra Peninsula from the top, and take a short break at **Lang Co Beach**, one of the most beautiful beaches in Vietnam.

Next, we'll stop to visit the **Museum of Cham Sculpture**, which houses the world's largest collection of Cham sculpture, and **Ngũ Hành Sơn ("The Marble Mountains")** in Da Nang.

Arrive in Hội An in the afternoon; after checking in we'll have some free time to explore the old town.

Our hotel tonight is in the heart of the Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and within easy walking distance of all the main sites.

Accommodations at La Charm Hoi An Hotel & Spa or similar

Day 8 Feb 17 (Mon) Hội An – The Peaceful Meeting Place (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants.

Enjoy a full-day excursion to Hội An, a charming and historic trading center that was once known as "Faifo" to the earliest Western traders, an important port for the Dutch, Portuguese, Italian, Chinese, Japanese, and other merchant vessels from the Far East.

We'll start out with a visit to the **Phuc Kien Temple** located in the center of Hoi An, with partially gilded statues reflecting the influences of both Chinese and Japanese styles. The pagoda is dedicated to sailors and fishermen, and the chapel has origins dating back to the 1700s.

Next, we will stop at the **Museum of Sa Huynh Culture**, located near the iconic **Japanese Covered Bridge**, for a look at Vietnam's pre-historic Bronze Age civilization. The museum contains exhibitions from the earliest period of Hội An's history, offering a glimpse into the city's rich and fascinating past.

Later in the afternoon after lunch will take a boat trip on the **Thu Bồn River** to **Kim Bồng Woodworking Village** on **Cẩm Kim Island**. Here, you will see skilled woodworkers and shipbuilding families who have been practicing their craft for generations. It's a unique opportunity to experience the traditional way of life in this part of Vietnam.

In the evening, we will have time to leisurely explore Hội An Ancient Town on our own.

Accommodations at La Charm Hoi An Hotel & Spa or similar

Day 8 Feb 18 (Tue) UNESCO World Heritage My Son (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants.

After breakfast we will depart to visit **My Son**, a UNESCO World Heritage site located 50 km southwest of Hội An. My Son was once the capital and religious center of the Cham people and is considered to be one of Southeast Asia's greatest archaeological sites, along with Angkor in Cambodia, Bagan in Myanmar, Ayutthaya in Thailand, and Borobudur in Indonesia. The towers and sanctuaries here were built between the 7th and 13th centuries. During our visit, we will explore the lush valley and learn

about the Cham civilization and their beliefs. We will have the opportunity to admire the intricate carvings and sculptures on the temples and learn about their significance.

Return to Hội An for lunch around 1:00 pm. In the afternoon, we will have free time to go shopping or explore the town at our own pace. Hội An is known for its beautiful lanterns, tailor-made clothing, and handcrafted souvenirs.

Accommodations at La Charm Hoi An Hotel & Spa or similar

Day 9 Feb 19 (Wed) Hội An - Da Nang - Ho Chi Minh City (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants

Today we will fly to Ho Chi Minh City, also known as Sài Gòn, Vietnam's largest city.

Check out from our hotel and transfer to Da Nang International Airport.

2:10 PM Depart for Ho Chi Minh City on **Vietnam Airlines flight VN127**.

3:55 PM Arrive in Ho Chi Minh City at **Tân Sơn Nhất International Airport**. Claim your luggage and **wait for your tour escort** before exiting.

Transfer to our Ho Chi Minh City Hotel. Our hotel tonight is located on one of Ho Chi Minh City's trendiest fashion streets, **Le Thanh Ton** street. It is only one block from the famous **Bến Thành Market**.

Accommodations at Liberty Central Saigon Hotel or similar

Day 10 Feb 20 (Thu) Mỹ Tho – Canals of the Mekong Delta (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants

This morning, we leave Ho Chi Minh city for **Mỹ Tho**, located on the northern banks of the **Mekong River Delta**, about two hours away from Ho Chi Minh City.

We'll take a cruise through the fish farms in the canals along the **Mekong River** and stop at a small island to visit a local fruit garden, coconut candy workshop, a bee farm and drink Vietnamese honey tea.

Sample coconut milk and seasonal fruit while listening to traditional Vietnamese music. Riding a rowing boat on a small canal under a green canopy of water-coconut trees, we'll catch a glimpse of the daily activities of the local people. Lunch at a local restaurant will feature **Elephant's ear fish**, a local delicacy.

Afterwards return to Ho Chi Minh City, where we will have some free time to explore and shop.

Accommodations at Liberty Central Saigon Hotel or similar

Day 11 Feb 21 (Fri) Ho Chi Minh City (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel, lunch and dinner at local restaurants

This morning, we will depart for our tour of Ho Chi Minh City. Our first stop is the **Saigon Central Post Office**, built by the French in the 19th century.

Then proceed to visit the **Reunification Hall (Hội trường Thống Nhất)**, formerly the Presidential Palace of the Republic of Vietnam, and the **War Remnants Museum** which primarily contains exhibits relating to the American phase of the Vietnam War.

After lunch, we'll head to the **Thien Hau ("Empress of Heaven") Temple** in the Cholon (Chinatown) District.

Then hit the **Bến Thành Market**, the symbol of the city, and **An Dong Market**, the city's largest wholesale fashion market. We'll have some more free time in the evening to explore on your own and shop before we head home tomorrow.
