### Day 1: TOKYO » HAKONE

## [ATTRACTIONS & ACTIVITIES]

### Lake Ashi

Lake Ashi lies at the heart of the Hakone area. Its shores are lined with historic sites, notable temples, delicious local food, and scenic viewpoints. The iconic views of Mt. Fuji rising above Lake Ashi are especially famous.



### Forest Adventure Hakone

Set in the great outdoors of Hakone, this treetop adventure park is packed with activities that children and adults alike can enjoy to the fullest. Crossing between trees, tackling swaying bridges, and soaring above the forest offer thrills you can only experience here. Guests can choose the easygoing Canopy Course or the more challenging Adventure Course, selecting the style that best suits their level and excitement.



### Mount Fuji World Heritage Center

The center brings together preservation, communication, exchange, and research to help people understand and share the cultural value of Mount Fuji as a World Heritage site.



### Fujisan Hongu Sengen Taisha Shrine

Fujisan Hongu Sengen Taisha Shrine, in Fujinomiya, Shizuoka, is the head shrine of over 1,300 Sengen and Asama shrines. Built over 1,000 years ago to appease Mount Fuji's eruptions, it serves as a spiritual site for climbers to pray and purify themselves before ascending the mountain. The shrine showcases unique architecture and beautiful cherry blossoms in spring.



### Shiraito Falls

A nationally designated scenic spot and natural monument, where Mt. Fuji's spring water flows in hundreds of thin streams over a wide curved cliff, creating a graceful, silk-like appearance and a beautifully atmospheric setting.



### Lake Kawaguchi

Lake Kawaguchi, one of the Fuji Five Lakes, offers stunning views of Mount Fuji. Ideal for nature lovers, this spot is perfect for cycling along scenic paths or exploring nearby trails. Enjoy the serene landscapes and make unforgettable memories at this picturesque retreat.



### Aokigahara Forest

Aokigahara Forest, also known as the Sea of Trees, is a fascinating and mysterious place located at the northwest base of Mount Fuji in Japan.

### Saiko Iyashi no Sato Nenba (Healing Village)

Saiko Iyashi no Sato Nenba is located on the shore of Lake Saiko, one of the Fuji Five Lakes (which is part of the Mount Fuji World Cultural Heritage site). This restored thatched-roof village, rebuilt after the original settlement was lost in a 1966 typhoon, preserves the lifestyle and cultural heritage shaped alongside Mount Fuji and offers visitors an authentic experience of traditional rural Japan.



### Kubota Itchiku Art Museum

A unique museum that displays kimono created by Kubota Itchiku, who spent his lifetime reviving the lost art of Tsujigahana silk dyeing.
